- Track behavior with consistency
- Choose prize types that reinforce the right habits

Tiered Prize Strategy Chart

Quick Wins

- Behavior Examples: Following directions, quiet lining up, raising hand
- Prize Types: Mini erasers, stickers, puzzle balls
- Suggested Products: Animal Erasers, Puzzle Balls, Self-Vending Mixes

Effort Earners

- Behavior Examples: Completing work, staying on task, helping classmates
- Prize Types: Skydivers, fidget toys, mini rulers
- Suggested Products: Skydivers, Fidget Soccer Balls, Ruler Sets

Superstars

- Behavior Examples: Leadership, perfect week, major improvement
- Prize Types: Plush toys, premium mixes, collectible capsules
- Suggested Products: Premium Crane Mix, Plush Puppets, Series 3 Capsules
